

ORDINANCE NO. 261

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1970, AND FIXING SALARIES AND WAGE RATES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Southmont, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1970, as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of twelve (12) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of twelve (12) mills.

SECTION 2. That salaries and wages be fixed for the fiscal year 1970 as follows:


