

ORDINANCE NO. 186

Vacating Peach Alley and Reserving Certain Rights-of-way
and Easements Therein.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that Peach Alley from its intersection with the southerly side of Apple Alley to the northerly line of Southmont Blvd. and running between Lot No. 642 and Lot No. 643 on the Plan of Southmont laid out by C.P. Collins, March 5, 1907, for Cambria Land and Improvement Company Limited shall be vacated and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That the rights of way for all necessary and convenient sewers, water lines, gas lines, power and telephone lines now installed or that it may hereafter be necessary to install in said Peach Alley hereinabove vacated with the free and unrestricted right of ingress, egress, and regress at all times for constructing, maintaining and making the necessary repairs and extensions from time to time without any liabilities to the Borough shall be reserved, and the same hereby are reserved by the Borough of Southmont.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
