

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING HANNAH ALLEY AS A PUBLIC ALLEY.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the
B Borough of Southmont Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted
and ordained by the authority of the same:

That Hannah Alley as hereinafter described be and the
same is hereby adopted as one of the public alleys of the
said Borough:-- Beginning at a point on the easterly side
of Marion Street 173.33 feet from its intersection with
Millcreek Road; thence south 79 degrees 57 minutes east

344.92 feet to Orchard Street; thence south 12 degrees 21 minutes east 17.3 feet to a point; thence north 79 degrees 57 minutes west 342.37 feet to Mabion Street; thence north 20 degrees one minute west 18.48 feet to a point, the place of beginning, and being a 16 foot wide strip of land extending from Marion Street in an easterly direction to Orchard Street.
