

ORDINANCE NO. 178

An Ordinance authorizing and directing the paving of an unpaved portion of Leila Street in the Borough of Southmont from Helen Street eastward for a distance of 430.28 feet on the Southern side and for a distance of 625.48 feet on the Northern side of said Leila Street, and providing for the payment of costs thereof.

Foreward--It is to be noted here that the center portion of Leila Street has already been permanently improved by a concrete paving.

The Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. Leila Street, in the Borough of Southmont, from Helen Street eastward for a distance of 430.28 feet on the southern side and for a distance of 625.48 feet on the northern side, shall be paved.

Section 2. The President of Council and the Borough Secretary are hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts in the name of the Borough for the whole or any part of said work, or for materials or labor connected therewith, with such party or parties and upon such terms as the Council may determine or agree upon.

Section 3. The Borough Engineer is hereby designated as the person in charge of said work with full power to work for the Borough in all things connected with said work and to estimate and make the assessments.

Section 4. The costs and expenses of the entire work hereby authorized shall be paid by the Borough of Southmont and the owners of the real estate abutting or bounding on said side portions thereof to be paved in accordance with Section 1712 the Borough Code as amended. One-third (1/3) of said costs and expenses shall be paid by the Borough and the same is hereby appropriated therefore out of the funds now or hereafter in the treasury, and two-thirds (2/3) of said costs and expenses shall be paid by the owners of real estate bounding or abutting on said street and the same is hereby assessed according to the foot front rule, and the assessments appropriated therefore.

Section 5. Whatever curbing and/or guttering shall be necessary in the opinion of the Borough Engineer to make a complete job, shall be likewise constructed, and the entire costs thereof shall be assessed against the abutting properties according to the foot front rule.
