

ORDINANCE NO. 39

PROVIDING FOR THE PLACING OF SIDEWALKS ALONG IMPROVED HIGHWAYS IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that whenever a highway is accepted and improved by placing a line of curbing along said highway and the roadway of said highway is paved, same shall be and hereby is designated as an improved highway.

Section 2. Whenever deemed necessary for the protection of pedestrians the Borough Council may order the property owners along all or any portion designated by them of any improved highway in the Borough of Southmont to proceed to place a sidewalk along said highway according to the plans and specifications prepared by the Borough Engineer and it shall be the duty of the Street Commissioner to give notice to all such property owners requiring such owners, within 15 days after service of such notices, to proceed to place sidewalks along their property as above described and such notices shall be served on the owner personally, if such owners reside on the premises, otherwise on the tenant, if there be a resident tenant, otherwise by posting a copy of the notice on the premises or advertising same in one of the Johnstown papers, if the property be unimproved or unoccupied for a period of ten (10) days. Upon failure of any such property owners to provide sidewalks, the Borough may proceed to cause the same to be done and the expense thereof with a penalty of 20 per centum added, which may be collected from the property or the owners in the manner provided in the general ordinances by filing a lien therefore and bringing the proper action thereon or from the owners of the property by any appropriate action.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Passed finally in Council this 13th day of October, 1924.
