

ORDINANCE NO. 255

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1968, AND SALARIES AND WAGES OF BOROUGH OFFICIALS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Southmont, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1968, as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of twelve (12) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of twelve (12) mills.

SECTION 2. That the salaries or other compensations of Borough Officials, Appointees and Employees be fixed as follows:

Secretary	\$100.00 per month
Treasurer	65.00 per month
Mayor	50.00 per month
Street Commissioner	\$ 500.00 per month
Policemen	\$ 375.00 per month
Chief of Police	400.00 per month
Extra Police & Extra Hours	2.00 per hour
Truck Drivers	\$ 2.05 per hour
Regular Labor	1.75 per hour Maximum
	1.65 per hour Minimum
Extra Laborers	1.50 per hour

SECTION 3. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same effects this ordinance.
