

ORDINANCE NO. 23

ACCEPTING A PORTION OF SHADY LANE IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY ESTABLISHING THE WIDTHS, PROVIDING FOR THE PAVING AND APPROPRIATING THE MONEY FOR PAVING AND IMPROVING SAID PORTION OF SHADY LANE.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that that portion of Shady Lane from its intersection with the Hochstein Road to its intersection with Cox Street within the limits of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, shall be accepted and the same hereby is accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. That the width of said portion of Shady Lane shall be established and the same hereby is established as follows: From its intersection with Hochstein Road to its intersection with Thumb Alley the entire width of said street is established at 50 feet, the width of the roadway is established at 24 feet from face to face of curb, and the width of the sidewalks are established at 13 feet from the face of the curb to the property line. From its intersection with Thumb Alley to its intersection with Gray Alley the entire width of said Street is established at 36 feet, the width of the roadway is established at 24 feet from face to face of curb and the width of the sidewalks are established at 6 feet from the face of the curb to the property line. From its intersection with Gray Alley to its intersection with Cox Street the entire width of said street is established at 34 feet the width of

the roadway is established at 22 feet from face to face of curb and the width of the sidewalks are established at 6 feet from the face of the curb to the property line.

Section 3. That that portion of Shady Lane from its intersection with Hochstein Road to its intersection with Cox Street shall be and the same hereby is authorized to be graded and paved with a reinforced concrete pavement, together with all necessary sewers, drains, and incidental work thereto in accordance with the plans, specifications and directions of the Borough Engineers. The Committee on Highways and Sewers shall be authorized and hereby are authorized to proceed with said work on the foot front plan and in accordance with the petition on file for the paving of said portion of Shady Lane.

Section 4. That one third of the total cost of grading, paving and improving of said portion of Shady Lane shall be appropriated and the same hereby is appropriated and the Borough Treasurer is hereby authorized to make payments on same from time to time on estimates prepared by the Borough Engineer approved by the Council.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
