

ORDINANCE NO. 40

VACATING A PORTION OF LENOX ALLEY AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA., AND RESERVING CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAYS AND EASEMENTS THEREIN.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same that that portion of Lenox Alley as shown on the Borough Map extending from Bliss Street to Gardner Street shall be and the same is hereby vacated as a public highway.

Section 2. The right-of-ways for all necessary and convenient sewers, water lines, gas lines, power and telephone lines now installed or that it may hereafter be necessary to install in that portion of Lenox Alley herein above vacated with the free and unrestricted right of ingress, egress and regress at all times for constructing and maintaining and making the necessary repairs and extensions from time to time without any liabilities to the Borough or any Public Service Corporations, shall be and the same are hereby reserved by the Borough of Southmont.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
