

ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH COMPENSATION FOR BOROUGH FORCES TO PERFORM WORK OTHER THAN NORMAL DUTIES ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 416

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF COMPENSATION TO THE BOROUGH FOR USE OF BOROUGH FORCES TO PERFORM WORK OTHER THAN NORMAL DUTIES, TO PROVIDE FOR A YEARLY RESOLUTION for HOURLY CHARGES TO BOROUGH RESIDENTS WHEN THIS WORK IS PERFORMED BY BOROUGH FORCES FOR THEIR BENEFIT, AND TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority vested in the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, the Borough of desirous of establishing compensation to be paid to the Borough by borough residents when Borough forces perform work for their benefit or perform work because the borough residents refuse to correct conditions which the Borough has established regulations by ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION I: SHORT TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known and referred to as the "Ordinance to Establish Compensation for Borough Forces to Perform work other than Normal Duties."

SECTION II: STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF BOROUGH FORCES TO PERFORM WORK OTHER THAN THEIR NORMAL DUTIES FOR BOROUGH RESIDENTS

1. Borough forces and borough equipment may perform work other than their normal duties for Borough residents under the conditions set forth in Section II 2. The charge to the borough resident for this service shall be the current Southmont Borough hourly rate for wages for borough employees and for borough equipment used as set by a yearly Resolution passed by the Borough at its reorganization meeting.

2. Southmont Borough may perform this type of work if the borough residents request the Borough to perform the work on the borough residence. Southmont Borough may also perform work for the benefit of borough residents who refuse to correct conditions which the borough has established regulations by ordinances. When this work is performed by Southmont Borough, the borough shall not be construed as a private contractor.

SECTION III: PENALTIES

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor which is punishable by a fine of not less than \$100.00, nor more than \$300.00, or in default of payment of such fine, then be imprisoned for a period of not more than 90 days, or both. Each day of violation shall be considered a separate and distinct offense.

SECTION IV: SEVERABILITY

In the event that any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remainder of such Ordinance shall not be invalidated by such action.

SECTION V: CONFLICT

Any ordinances or any part of any ordinance which conflicts with this Ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.


SECTION VI: EFFECTIVE DATE
