

ORDINANCE NO. 113

AUTHORIZING THE OPENING OF A STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, FROM THE EXTENSION OF GRAND STREET AT THE LINE OF THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN TO THE LINE OF WESTMONT BOROUGH AT A POINT ON MILLCREEK ROAD.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the Borough of Southmont, and it is hereby enacted and ordained, that a street or road be opened within the Borough of Southmont from a point on the City line of the City of Johnstown being the extension of Grand Street, thence by an arc with a radius of 287.04 feet, a distance of three hundred sixteen and fifteen hundredths (316.15) feet; thence north 25 degrees 51' 30" east, six hundred seventy and forty-two hundredths (670.42) feet; thence by an arc with a radius of 1910.08 feet, a distance of three hundred fourteen and forty-four hundredths (314.44) feet; thence north 17 degrees 20' 30" east nine hundred seventeen and seven hundredths (917.07) feet; thence by an arc with a radius of 716.18 feet, a distance of six hundred eighty-six and twenty-five hundredths (686.25) feet; thence north 72 degrees 24' 30" east, three hundred ninety-seven and sixty-six hundredths (397.66) feet; thence by an arc with a radius of 716.78 feet, a distance of eight hundred two and seventy-one hundredths (802.71) feet; thence south 43 degrees 22' 30" east, four thousand and fifty seven (4057) feet; thence by a "V" to the Borough line of the Borough of Westmont at a point along Millcreek Road.

Section 2. The proper officers of the Borough of Southmont are hereby authorized and directed to take such legal steps as may be necessary for the opening of said street, and for the assessment of damages and benefits by reason thereof before said street is actually opened.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
