

ORDINANCE NO. 93

PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A 4 FOOT WATER
CONDUIT AND THE APPROPRIATION OF NECESSARY RIGHT OF WAY.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and the same hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that a water conduit 4 feet in diameter and approximately 300 feet in length shall be constructed along the northerly side of Wonder Street, beginning at the intersection of the present outlet of the 24" Terra Cotta Pipe at the westerly boundary line of Lot No. 1 of the Sheesley Supply Company plan of lots and extending in a westerly direction through land in possession of Martha A. Gore, George Peden and Henry M. Fisher, and ending at the end of the present 24" Terra Cotta Pipe in lands of Henry M. Fisher, as indicated on Borough Plan, index number 7-B-154, showing Plan of Water Conduit to replace Terra Cotta Pipe along Wonder Street.

Section 2. That sufficient land in possession of said Martha A. Gore, George Peden and Henry M. Fisher, necessary for the purpose of construction, repairing and maintaining said water conduit, shall be appropriated and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of constructing, operating, repairing and maintaining said water conduit.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.

Passed finally in Council this 9th day of December 1929.
