

ORDINANCE NO. 114

PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF A SANITARY SEWER AND  
THE CONDEMNATION AND THE APPROPRIATION OF THE NECESSARY  
EASEMENTS OR RIGHTS-OF-WAYS.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that a 10" sanitary sewer be constructed and extended from the existing manhole on Miller Court at the intersection of Apple Alley across a portion of Lots A, B, 11 and 10 to a proposed manhole in the center of Adams St. on the line between Upper Yoder Township and the Borough of Southmont, as indicated on plan 10-P-1146 entitled, Southmont Borough, Upper Yoder Township, Showing Sanitary Sewer Extension to Adams Street and Trunk Line for Sewer District No. 1, dated July 14, 1938, and in accordance with the said plans and the standard specifications of the Borough of Southmont and under the directions of the Engineer of the Borough of Southmont.

Section 2. That a right-of-way and easement across the above described land in possession of Harold B. Rowland and Mary V. Rowland, Benjamin H. Dunkle and Blanche T. Dunkle and Wilford L. Gore and Gerrie A. Gore, necessary for the purpose of constructing, repairing and maintaining said sanitary sewer shall be appropriated and condemned and hereby is appropriated and condemned for the purpose of constructing, operating, repairing and maintaining said sanitary sewer.

Section 3. That Viewers be appointed according to law to assess damages and benefits accruing, if any, by reason of constructing, operating, repairing and maintaining said sanitary sewer as above described from Miller Court to Adams Street, if the same cannot be amicably agreed upon between the Borough of Southmont and the property owners affected by said improvements.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
