

ORDINANCE NO. 105

PROVIDING FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF A PORTION OF MILLCREEK ROAD IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT AND BOROUGH OF WESTMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA., AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, ESTABLISHING THE WIDTH THEREOF AND THE OPENING OF SAME,

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Purgees and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and the same hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that, that portion of Millcreek Road from its intersection with Ninth Avenue to its intersection with Third Avenue, a boundary line highway, within the limits of the Borough of Southmont and the Borough of Westmont, shall be accepted and the same hereby is accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. That the width of said portion of Millcreek Road from its intersection with Tenth Avenue to its intersection with Third Avenue, shall be established and the same hereby is established at forty-eight (48) feet.

Section 3. That Millcreek Road from its intersection with Weaver Court in the Borough of Southmont to its intersection with Third Avenue in the Borough of Westmont, shall be opened, graded, drained and improved with a broken stone base and water bound binder course, with a traffic surface width of not less than eighteen feet, with not less than five foot berms on either side, exclusive of cutters.

Section 4. That said improvements shall be made as a Civil Works Project and that the Borough of Southmont and Borough of Westmont shall pay for all costs and expense incurred in excess of aid and assistance furnished by the Civil Works Administration or otherwise on a fifty-fifty basis.

Section 5. That the Treasurers and the proper Borough Officials of the Borough of Southmont and Borough of Westmont are hereby authorized to pay each Borough's share of said cost and expense from the general funds of the Borough, on estimates and invoices properly authorized and approved by the Borough Council.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
