

ORDINANCE NO. 243

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Southmont, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, that the Income Tax Ordinance which imposed taxes for general Borough purposes, as follows: (a) One-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) per cent of all compensation earned by residents during the year beginning January 1, 1966, and ending December 31, 1966; and (b) One-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) per cent of all net profits earned in or by business, professions, and other activities conducted by residents during the year beginning January 1, 1966 and ending December 31, 1966, has been re-enacted without substantial change and the same tax imposed for the year 1967.
