

ORDINANCE NO. 19

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF THOBURN ALLEY AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that the portion of Thoburn alley in the above borough as shown on the Borough map extending from the northerly side of Quince Alley N. $16^{\circ}36'30''$ E. 154.32 feet to the southerly side of Hillcrest Avenue, shall be and the same is hereby vacated as a public highway.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
