ORDINANCE NO. 532

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC AND ROADWAY REGULATIONS OF THE BOROUGH, THE AUTHORITY OF PLACING OF SIGNAGE, AND PROVIDING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF SAME AND SHALL REPEAL ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES REGULATING SAME.

WHEREAS, Borough of Southmont ("Borough") has passed Ordinances through its years (Nos. 111, 128 and 410) which regulate the various parameters of the roadways within the Borough (speed, stopping, parking, directional, and signage, etc.); and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Borough to update and consolidate its Ordinances regulating the roadways within the Borough; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Southmont and it is hereby enacted as follows:

1. **General.** Pursuant to Pennsylvania's Vehicle Code (75 Pa.C.S.A. §101 et al.), persons and owners operating motorized vehicles on Borough roadways must comply with the all-applicable provisions of Pennsylvania's Vehicle Code and are subject to penalties for violations of same. The Borough hereby incorporates Pennsylvania's Vehicle Code into this Ordinance as if same was set forth in full as may be necessary to effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance.

2. **Speed Limits:** With the exception of Millcreek Road, from Menoher Boulevard (State Route 271) to Bucknell Avenue, the Borough-wide speed limit on its roadways shall be twenty-five (25) miles an hour. It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to be operated on the roadways of the Borough at a rate of speed in excess of twenty-five (25) miles an hour.

On Millcreek Road, from Menoher Boulevard (State Route 271) to Bucknell Avenue, the speed limit shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour on said roadway and it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to be operated in excess of this speed on this portion of Millcreek Road.

3. **Parking - General:**

a. No motor vehicle shall be permitted to park in a zone designated by the Borough or its designee as a handicapped parking zone except where a vehicle parked in said handicapped zone clearly displays a permit issued by a proper authority granting said vehicle authorization to be parked in a handicapped parking zone.

- b. Over the time limit at a parking meter or on a street or highway with a time limit for parking.
  - c. No motor vehicle shall park near or in front of the Southmont Borough Volunteer Fire Department station door or entrance which hinders the ingress and egress of the Fire Department vehicles and/or equipment.
  - d. No motor vehicle shall park within fifteen (15) feet of any intersection of streets.
  - e. No motor vehicle shall park in a manner that obstructs a crosswalk, sidewalk or in a manner that obstructs vehicular or pedestrian traffic.
  - f. No motor vehicle shall park in front of private driveway as to hinder ingress and egress.
  - g. When parking on a Borough roadway in a permitted area, all vehicles must be parallel parked and shall be no more than twelve (12) inches from the curb.
  - h. No motor vehicle shall park in a manner that constitutes double parking.
  - i. No motor vehicle shall park on the sidewalk or curb.
  - j. No motor vehicle shall park within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant.
  - k. No motor vehicle shall park in an area designated as a “no parking area” by way of painted curbing. Yellow or red painted curbing shall designate that area which is immediately next to said curbing as a “no parking” area.
  - l. No motor vehicle that has an unloaded weight of more than four (4) tons (eight thousand (8000) pounds shall park overnight upon any Borough roadway.
  - m. No motor vehicle shall park in an area designated as a “no parking area” by way of signage. The Borough may designate said areas specifically by way of listing same in an Appendix designating “no parking” areas and is attached to this Ordinance.
4. **Traffic Signs:** The Borough may utilize signage to post or notify the public of traffic regulations to include, but are not limited to: stop intersections, one-way streets, speed limits, no parking areas, and other regulations. The Borough hereby has the authority to procure and place signage as may be necessary to regulate and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance. Although the Borough may utilize signage to post and/or notify the public of certain regulations, the lack of such signage shall not prevent the enforcement of the regulations in this Ordinance.

The Borough has designated intersections in the Borough where traffic must stop. These intersections are set forth in the Appendix attached to this Ordinance.

5. **Operation of Vehicles on Sidewalks:** It shall be unlawful to operate any motorized vehicle including but not limited to motor vehicles and motorcycles on or upon any sidewalk within the Borough of Southmont.
6. **Vehicle Weight Limits:** No truck having an unloaded weight of more than four (4) tons, (eight thousand (8000 pounds) shall enter upon or travel upon any street or highway of the Borough of Southmont except for the purpose of delivery within the Borough. The weight limit shall be four (4) tons unless otherwise specifically posted.
7. **One-Way Streets:** The Borough may designate certain roadways to be “one-way”, and all vehicular traffic is permitted to proceed only in one (1) direction as indicated. The Borough roadways which are “one way” are hereby listed in the attached Appendix to this Ordinance.
8. **Vegetation and Site-Lines:** The purpose of this section to identify and regulate locations in the Borough where road-side vegetation or obstructions may result in reduced traffic and pedestrian safety. Accordingly, all vegetation (grasses, trees, shrubs, etc.), fences, or other obstructions shall be maintained or installed in such a manner as to allow a minimum site-line of 200 feet on roadways. Additionally, these obstructions shall be maintained or installed in such a manner as to keep signs visible to drivers.
9. **Special Purpose Parking Zones:** The Borough may designate certain areas of roadways to be designated with special parking zones, such as handicap zone or otherwise. These special parking zones will be designated with blue curbing and/or signage. The Borough may designate said special parking zones specifically by way of listing same in an Appendix designating “special parking” areas and is attached to this Ordinance.
10. **Liability of Operator and/or Owner:** For the purposes of this Ordinance, when a violation of this Ordinance occurs, either the operator or the owner may be held responsible for the violation under this Ordinance depending on the type of Ordinance violated and the circumstances surrounding the violation.

**11. Violations and Penalties:**

a. Any person or owner who violates a parking provision of this Ordinance shall pay a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and the costs of prosecution. For all other violations committed under this Ordinance, either those designated herein or which occur under Pennsylvania's Vehicle Code, shall pay a fine set forth in Pennsylvania's vehicle code and the cost of prosecution.

b. Additional Penalties: In addition to the above penalties, any vehicle, trailer or obstruction that is parked or located in the roadway may be towed or removed at the owner's expense at the discretion of the West Hills Police Department or other designated police department.

12. Severability: If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof had not been included herein.

12. Repeal: All Ordinances inconsistent with this action are hereby repealed.


13. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days upon its passing.
