

TAX ORDINANCE NO. 224

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1964.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Southmont, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1: That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1964, as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of (10) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of (10) mills.

SECTION 2. That the salaries or other compensations of Borough Officials, Appointees and Employees be fixed as follow:
