

ORDINANCE NO. 118

PROVIDING FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE UTILITY OF
ROADWAY ON CHRISTINE COURT, THE PLACING OF CURBS AND SIDE-
WALKS, REPAIR AND IMPROVING OF ROADWAY AND FOR THE PAYMENT
THEREOF.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town
Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa.,
and it hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of
said, that the width of the Roadway of Christine Court
shall be reestablished and the same hereby is reestablished
at nineteen and five tenths (19.5) feet between curbs.

Section 2. That a concrete sidewalk and integral curb four feet
in width shall be constructed on the southern side and a
6" x 24" concrete curb shall be constructed on the northern
side of Christine Court in accordance with plans and spec-
ifications on file with the Borough Engineer and contract
approved and authorized by the Borough Council.

Section 3. That the Highway Commissioner and the Borough
Engineer are hereby authorized and directed to make the
necessary repairs and widen the width of the improved
Roadway of Christine Court, to include the full width of
nineteen and five (19.5) feet by placing a broken stone
base on either side of the present concrete roadway, one (1)
foot in width on the southern side and four and five tenths
(4.5) feet in width on the northern side and resurface the
entire width and the additional width of stone base with an
asphaltic concrete surface.

Section 4. That the whole cost and expense of the concrete curbs
and sidewalks shall be assessed and the same is hereby
assessed to the abutting property owners, as provided for
by law.

Section 5. That all cost and expense of repairing and improving
the roadway shall be paid from the General Borough Fund
and the Borough Engineer is hereby authorized to make
payment of same upon receipt of properly approved estimates
and invoices.

Section 6. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the
same hereby are repealed.
