

ORDINANCE NO. 18

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A PORTION OF THOBURN ALLEY AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council and the Burgess of the Borough of Southmont and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that the portion of Thoburn Street in the above Borough as shown on the borough Map extending from the northernly side of Quince Alley N. 16° 36' 30" E. 154.32 feet to the southerly side of Hillcrest Ave. shall be and the same is hereby accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
