

ORDINANCE NO. 163

VACATING BRIAR ALLEY AND RESERVING CERTAIN RIGHT OF
WAYS AND EASEMENTS THEREIN.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same that Briar Alley, extending from the north side of Hershberger Street to the south side of Bluff Street and running between Lots Nos. 850 and 851 on the plan of Southmont laid out by C.P. Collins, March 5, 1907, for Cambria Land and Improvement Company Limited in the Borough of Southmont, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania shall be vacated and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That the right of ways for all necessary and convenient sewers, water lines, gas lines, power and telephone lines, now installed or that it may hereafter be necessary to install in said Briar Alley hereinabove vacated, with the free and unrestricted right of ingress, egress and regress at all times for constructing, maintaining and making the necessary repairs and extensions from time to time without any liabilities to the Borough shall be reserved and the same hereby are reserved by the Borough of Southmont.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
