

ORDINANCE NO. 141

PROVIDING FOR SET BACKS AND BUILDING LINES ON ALL STREET AND AVENUES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that Ordinance No. 38, providing for set backs and building lines for all streets and avenues and providing penalties for the violation thereof in the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., shall be amended by adding the following:

Section 7. In the event that on account of the location of existing buildings, topographical or other conditions the set backs or building lines established shall be inequitable in the opinion of Council. Council may by resolution or motion alter the building lines or set backs hereinbefore provided for.

Section 8. All alterations of the building line or set back heretofore made or granted by resolution or motion by the Council are hereby ratified and affirmed.
