

ORDINANCE NO. 147

ACCEPTING A PORTION OF ORCHARD STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA. AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, ESTABLISHING THE WIDTHS AND GRADES THEREOF AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAME TOGETHER WITH ALL INCIDENTAL WORK, APPROPRIATING THE MONEY AND ASSESSING THE COST THEREOF ON THE FOOT FRONT PLAN.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that, that portion of Orchard Street from its intersection with Olive Street at Station 17+ 61.97 to Station 8+ 30.78 within the limits of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., shall be and the same hereby is accepted as a public Highway.

Section 2. That the width of the said portion of Orchard Street shall be established and the same is hereby established at sixty feet; that the width of the roadway and sidewalks shall be established, and the same are hereby established at thirty feet from face to face of curb for roadway and fifteen feet from face of curb to property line for sidewalk; and that the grade shall be established and the same are hereby established as shown on the plan and profile 3A-12 sheet 19 dated August 18, 1938 on file in the office of the Borough Engineer.

Section 3. That said portion of Orchard Street from its intersection with Olive Street at station 17+ 61.97 to station 8+ 30.78 excluding the intersection of Gradner Street shall be paved, and the same is hereby authorized to be paved, including storm sewers and all necessary and incidental work in accordance with the plans and specifications and directions of the Borough Engineer.

Section 4. That the Committee on highways and sewers shall be authorized and hereby is authorized to proceed with the completion of said work on the foot front plan in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 1712 of Act July 10, 1947 P.L. 1921.

Section 5. That one third of the total cost and expense of paving and improving of said portion of Orchard Street together with all necessary and incidental work shall be appropriated from the General Fund and the Treasurer hereby authorized to make payments of same upon approval of the Borough Engineer and by the Borough Council fifteen (15) days after completion of the work.

Section 6. That two thirds of the total cost and expense of paving and improving of said portion of Orchard Street together with all necessary and incidental work as provided by the Borough Ordinance shall be assessed and the same is hereby assessed in the foot front plan to the abutting property owners.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
