

ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING LEON STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, ESTABLISHING THE WIDTHS, PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAME AND APPROPRIATING THE MONEY FOR THE SAID GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAID LEON STREET.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that Leon Street from its intersection with State Street to its intersection with Leila Street within the limits of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., shall be accepted and hereby is accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. That the widths of Leon Street shall be established and the same hereby are established at sixty feet; that the widths of the roadway and sidewalks shall be established and the same hereby are established at twenty-four feet from face to face of curb for roadway and eighteen feet from face of curb to property line for sidewalks.

Section 3. That Leon Street from its intersection with State Street to its intersection with Leila Street, including the necessary highway intersections and returns, shall be and the same hereby is authorized to be graded, drained, curbed and paved with a reinforced cement concrete pavement or a concrete base with a Bituminous surface, together with all necessary sanitary sewer, storm sewer, manholes, drop inlets and other work incidental thereto in accordance with the plans, specifications and directions of the Borough Engineer as prayed for by a petition of a majority of the property owners in interest and in number abutting on said Leon Street acknowledged on the 9th day of July A.D. 1928.

Section 4. That the committee on highways and sewers shall be authorized and hereby is authorized to proceed with the advertisements and completion of said work on the foot front plan in accordance with the petition on file for the improvements of said Leon Street.

Section 5. That one-third of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said Leon Street together with all incidental work thereto shall be apportioned and the same hereby is apportioned and the Borough Treasurer authorized to make payments of same from time to time on estimates prepared by the Borough Engineer and approved by the Borough Council.

Section 6. That two-thirds of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said Leon Street together with all incidental work thereto and the total cost of all curbing and sanitary sewer, as provided by Borough Ordinance shall be assessed and the same hereby is assessed on the foot front plan to the abutting property owners.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
