

ORDINANCE NO. 87

APPROVING AND ESTABLISHING THE LINES, GRADES, DRAINAGE STRUCTURES AND ALL OTHER STRUCTURES APPEARING ON THE PLANS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, SHOWING PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT ON HARSHBERGER AND LILLY STREETS IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA.,

Whereas, The Department of Highways has submitted to the Borough Council of the Borough of Southmont plans showing proposed construction work on State-aid Highway Application No. 5802, on Harshberger and Lilly Streets, from Station 0+ 00 to Station 25+ 70 a distance of 2570 feet, as shown by the plans of said Department of Highways, approved May 1st 1929, therefore,

Be it Resolved and Ordained that the Burgess and Council of the said Borough of Southmont ordain the said plans of the Department of Highways, together with the lines, grades, drainage structures and all other structures thereon shown, with full force and effect as the action of said Borough, and

Be it Further Ordained, That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
