

ORDINANCE NO. 37

ACCEPTING A PORTION OF LENOX ALLEY AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that, that portion of Lenox Alley as shown on the Borough Map extending from Bliss Street to Gardner Street shall be and the same is hereby accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.

Passed finally in Council this 11th day of August A.D. 1924.
