

BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT

ORDINANCE NO. 318

PROVIDING FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF A PORTION OF CELEST DRIVE AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough Council of the Borough of Southmont accepting those portions of Celeste Drive and Van-Guilder Street as described as follows as a public highway.

ALL that certain lot or piece of ground situate, lying and being in the Borough of Southmont, County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on corner of land of J & B. Partnership and the Cambria County Industrial Development Authority, which point is 97.75 feet from the Westerly side of State Highway Route 11011 spur, also known as Menoher Boulevard, thence along the Northerly side of land of J. & B Partnership South 49° 11' West a distance of 40.03 feet to a point on corner of land of J. & B Partnership and the Cambria County Industrial Development Authority, thence along line of land of the Cambria County Industrial Development Authority North 38° 34' East 112.30 feet to a point on the land of the Cambria County Industrial Development Authority, Thence through a 40 feet right of way known as Celeste Drive North 52° 51' East a distance of 40.01 feet to a point on corner of land of the Cambria County Industrial Development Authority, thence along line of land of the Cambria County Industrial Development Authority South 38° 34' East a distance of 109.74 feet to a point the place of beginning.

As it is in the best interest of the residence of the Borough of Southmont that the vacation occur.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that the portion of Celeste Drive and Van-Guilder Street described above be vacated as a public street within the Borough of Soutymont

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty days after passage.
