

ORDINANCE NO. 9

ESTABLISHING THE LINES, GRADES AND WIDTH OF ROADWAY AND SIDEWALKS OF LUZERNE STREET EXTENSION, A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same that the center line of Luzerne Street Extension, beginning at the intersection of Luzerne Street ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ in Westmont extended with the center line of the Millcreek Road, shall be established and hereby is established at N. 71° 04' E. a distance of 687 feet to the intersection of the boundary line between the Borough of Southmont and Westmont.

Section 2. That the width of Luzerne Street Extension shall be and hereby is established at 50 feet from property line to property line. That the width of the roadway shall be 20 feet from face of curb to face of curb; that the width of the sidewalk shall be 15 feet from the property line to the face of the curb; that the width of the sidewalk pavement shall be 5 feet beginning one foot outward from the property line.

Section 3. That the grade of the center line of said street shall be and hereby is established the same as that of the present pavement now placed thereon from the intersection of the Millcreek Road easterly to the Westmont Borough line.

Section 4. A plan showing the lines and width of Luzerne Street Extension titled Southmont Borough, Luzerne Street Extension showing established width of Street, roadway and sidewalk, dated May 23, 1921, further designated by index number 5-D-106 is on file in the office of S.F. Dickey and Co., Borough Engineers and with the Borough Secretary.

Section 5. That viewers be appointed according to law to assess damages done and benefits occurring, if any, by reason of the widening, alying out and opening of Luzerne Street Extension as a Public Highway from the intersection of the Millcreek Road to the Westmont Borough line, if same cannot be amiably agreed upon by the Borough of Southmont and the property owners affected by said improvements.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same hereby are repealed.
