

ORDINANCE NO. 126

PROVIDING FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF A PORTION OF DAHLIA STREET AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same that, that portion of Dahlia Street extending from the intersection of Queen Street to the intersection of Harsberger Street shall be accepted and the same hereby is accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
