

ORDINANCE NO. 14

Be it ordained and enacted, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the Council of the Borough of Southmont, County of Cambria and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that the portion of Hillcrest Avenue, formerly May Street, in the Borough of Southmont, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, as shown on the plan of Lots laid out by C.P. Collins, C.E. March 5th, 1907, for the Cambria Land and Improvement Company, between the points intersecting Gardner and Orchard Streets, and having a length of three hundred nine and thirty five hundredths (309.35) feet on its Northern boundary, and a length of four hundred twenty-four and six hundredths (424.06) feet on its Southern boundary, and being sixty (60) feet in width, a public highway in said Borough, be and the same is hereby vacated.
Passed finally in Council this 12th day of June A.D. 1922
