

## ORDINANCE NO. 446

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 399, WHICH CREATED THE OFFICE OF FULL OR PART TIME BOROUGH MANAGER AND PROVIDING FOR THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOROUGH MANAGER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Southmont:

SECTION 1. CREATION OF OFFICE. The office of Manager is hereby created pursuant to the terms of Act No. 581 of February 1, 1996, P.L. (1965), 1141, 53 P.S. 46141, as amended.

SECTION 2. APPOINTMENT OF MANAGER. The Manager shall be appointed by majority vote of the Council.

SECTION 3. REMOVAL OF MANAGER. The Council may remove the Manager at any time by a majority vote of its members.

SECTION 4. POWERS OF MANAGER. The Manager shall be the chief administrative officer of the Borough and shall be responsible to the Council for the proper administration of all departments.

SECTION 5. DUTIES OF MANAGER. Council shall determine and prescribe the duties and responsibilities of the Manager.

SECTION 6. BOND. The Manager shall be bonded as necessary.

SECTION 7. SAVING CLAUSE. If any section, subsection or sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision or decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance. All ordinances of the

Borough prescribing the duties of heads or departments shall remain in full force and effect except insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this ordinance in which case, the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.
