

ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A PORTION OF WEAVER COURT AS
A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town
Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County,
Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the
authority of the same, that the portion of Weaver Court in
the above Borough extending from Bliss Street to Gardner
Street being 16 feet in width and having a length of 517.24
feet, shall be and the same is hereby accepted as a public
highway.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
with the provisions of this ordinance, shall be and the
same are hereby repealed.
