

ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT ESTABLISHING THE WIDTH OF THE DRIVEWAY OR CARTWAY ON MENCHER HIGHWAY FROM THE INTERSECTION OF MARION STREET WESTWARD TO THE BOROUGH LINE, AND REQUIRING ABUTTING OWNERS TO SET OR PLACE CURBS.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Council and the Burgess of the Borough of Southmont, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that:

- Section 1. The width of the driveway or cartway of Mencher Highway from the intersection of Marion Street westward to the Borough line be, and the same is, hereby established at thirty-six (36) feet.
- Section 2. The property owners abutting on Mencher Highway within said limits shall be notified to set or place curbs along said driveway or cartway in accordance with the plans on file in the office of the Borough Engineer.
- Section 3. In the event of failure of the property owners to place or set curbs within fifteen days after notice, the Borough shall set or install the same and assess the cost thereof to the abutting property owners, in accordance with General Ordinance No. 3.
- Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
