

ORDINANCE NO. 29

ACCEPTING A PORTION OF ORCHARD STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, ESTABLISHING THE WIDTHS, PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAME AND APPROPRIATING THE MONEY FOR THE GRADING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAID PORTION OF ORCHARD STREET.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that that portion of Orchard Street from its intersection with the Millcreek Road to its intersection with the Southerly line of Lot No. 61 extended within the limits of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., shall be accepted and hereby is accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. That the width of said portion of Orchard Street shall be established and the same hereby is established at 60 feet. That the width of the roadway shall be established and the same hereby is established at 30 feet from face to face of curb and the widths of the sidewalks shall be established and the same hereby are established at 15 feet from face of curb to the property line.

Section 3. That the portion of Orchard Street from the end of the present paving at the northerly side of the property of John W. Walters to its intersection with the southerly line of Lot No. 61 extended shall be and the same hereby is authorized to be graded, curbed and paved with a reinforced concrete pavement, together with all necessary sanitary and storm sewers, manholes, drain inlets, and all other work incidental thereto, in accordance with the plans, specifications and directions of the Borough Engineer. The committee on highways and sewers shall be authorized and hereby are authorized to proceed with said work on the foot front plan and in accordance with the petition on file for the paving of said portion of Orchard Street.

Section 4. That one-third of the total cost of grading, paving and improving of said portion of Orchard Street shall be appropriated and the same hereby is appropriated and the Borough Treasurer is authorized to make payments on same from time to time on estimates prepared by the Borough Engineers approved by the Borough Council.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
