ORDINANCE NO. 306

ORDINANCE OF SOUTHMONT BOROUGH, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 1980.

1979

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted
by the Council of Southmont Borough, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 1: That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all
property within said municipality subject to taxation for the
fiscal year 1980⁷⁹ as follows:

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of twenty-two (22)
mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of twenty-
two (22) mills.

SECTION 2: That for the expenses, salaries and wages for the
fiscal year 1980, amounts are appropriated from the revenues
available for the said year for the purposes set forth and itemized
in the Budget Form on file in the Borough Office and as passed by the
Borough Council

SECTION 3: That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting
with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar
as the same affects this ordinance.
