A motion was made by Mr. Pile to approve the March 2010 Treasurers Report. Motion seconded by Mr. Strittmatter. All in favor, motion carried. A motion was made by Mr. Kory to note the receipt of the March 2010 Tax Collectors Report in the amount of \$62,153.28. Motion seconded by Mr. Strittmatter. All in favor, motion carried.

### Police Chief's Report

Chief Havas absent. Sgt. Musulin had nothing to report.

### Fire Company's Report

Chief Leckey reported storm damage done during heavy winds. Chief Leckey stated the Fire Company has been denied for both federal grants but is moving along with plans to refurbish the fire engine. Chief Leckey requested use of the dump trucks for the Jubilee. A motion was made by Mr. Ewald to approve allowing the Fire Company to use the dump trucks and police assistance for the Jubilee. Motion seconded by Mr. Danyluk. All in favor, motion carried. The Hilltop Ambulance Report was received and is on file.

### **Engineer's Report**

Mr. Rugh submitted recommendations to the Fire Company for repairing a crack in the wall of the garage. Mr. Rugh reported State Pipe Services, Inc. was awarded the State Street sanitary sewer bid and Robinson Pipe Cleaning was awarded the sanitary sewer cleaning and televising bid at the Special Bid Opening Meeting on April 12, 2010.

## **Zoning Officer's Report**

Mr. Wargo reported five zoning permits issued and three approved sewer compliance certificates. Mr. Wargo noted several property maintenance issues that are being monitored.

# Mayor's Report

Nothing to report.

## Manager's Report

Mr. Wargo reported audit reports requests have been submitted to the various agencies the Borough contributes money noting most reports have been received. A motion was made by Mr. Pile to approve changing the PLGIT Account to First Commonwealth with an interest rate of 1.55%. Motion seconded by Mr. Strittmatter. All in favor, motion carried. A motion was made by Mr. Morgan to approve making a Resolution required for the reimbursement of emergency funds from February storms. Motion seconded by Mr. Kory. All in favor, motion carried. Mr. Wargo stated lighting for the Borough building may be purchased from The Hite Company and a rebate is available for the lighting through First Energy. Mr. Wargo stated the original cost of the lighting is \$5,664.00 and the rebate is \$3,046.00 noting the total cost for the Borough would be \$2,618.00. Mr.

Wargo stated the new fixtures would allow a savings of \$1,718.00 per year in electricity. A motion was made by Mr. Kory to approve purchasing lighting from The Hite Company. Motion seconded by Mr. Morgan. All in favor, motion carried.

### Solicitor's Report

An Executive Session was called at 7:40 p.m. regarding legal matters. Council resumed its regularly scheduled meeting at 7:55 p.m. A motion was made by Mr. Pile to approve the cost rates submitted by Wessel & Co. Motion seconded by Mr. Ewald. All in favor, motion carried.

## Secretary's Report

A motion was made by Mr. Morgan to approve the County Aid Request in the amount of \$5,600.00 for 2010 Street Paving. Motion seconded by Mr. Kory. All in favor, motion carried. A motion was made by Mr. Pile to approve the Kline Kimlin 2009 Audit of Borough and Tax Collector funds. Motion seconded by Mr. Strittmatter. All in favor, motion carried. A motion was made by Mr. Danyluk to approve Resolution 2010-01 which provides for the disposition of past records. Motion seconded by Mr. Kory. All in favor, motion carried. A motion was made by Mr. Kory to allow Mr. Ewald, Mr. Morgan and Mr. Wargo to attend the Cambria County Borough Association Annual Spring Dinner Meeting on April 22, 2010. Motion seconded by Mr. Danyluk. All in favor, motion carried.
