

ORDINANCE NO. 188

PROVIDING FOR THE VACATING OF A PORTION OF PLUM ALLEY  
AND RESERVING CERTAIN RIGHTS OF WAY AND EASEMENTS THEREIN.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that Plum Alley from its intersection with the northerly line of Helen Street to its intersection with the southerly line Floyd Street, and running back between Lot No. 334 and Lot No. 335 on the Plan of Southmont laid out by C.P. Collins March 5, 1907, for Cambria Land and Improvement Company Limited, shall be vacated and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That the rights of way for all necessary and convenient sewers, water lines, gas lines, power and telephone lines, now installed or that it may hereafter be necessary to install in said Plum Alley hereinabove vacated, with the free and unrestricted right of ingress, egress and regress at all times for constructing, maintaining and making the necessary repairs and extensions from time to time without any liabilities to the Borough shall be reserved, and the same hereby are reserved by the Borough of Southmont.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
