

ORDINANCE NO. 191  
POLICE PENSION FUND

Providing for the adoption of a Pension Plan for the Police Officers of the Borough of Southmont pursuant to the requirements of Act No. 600, of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved the 29th day of May 1956, P.L. 1804, as amended: Providing for the contribution by the Police to the Police Pension Fund as established and for appropriations to be made thereto by the Borough.'

Whereas, The Act of May 29, 1956, P.L. 1804, as amended by Act No. 358 approved July 10, 1957 requires certain municipalities including the Borough of Southmont, to provide a Police Pension Fund or Annuity for the benefit of their Police Officers.

Now, therefore, Be It Ordained and Enacted By the Borough of Southmont aforesaid and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same, pursuant to and in compliance with the Act of May 29, 1956, P.L. 1804 as amended by Act No. 358, approved July 10, 1957 as follows:

Section 1. That the Borough of Southmont does hereby adopt a Police Pension Plan to become effective the thirty first day of December, 1958.

Section 2. That the plan adopted is hereby designated to be the Pension Plan for Police Officers as prepared by the Minnesota Mutual Life Insurance Company which plan is herein incorporated by reference.

Section 3. That the above Plan having been heretofore filed with and approved by the Auditor General's Department of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania the Borough Secretary is hereby directed to file any additional records with said Department as may be necessary to insure the approval of the Insurance and Annuity Contracts included in the Borough program.

Section 4. That the amount of contribution to be paid into the Police Pension Fund by the members of the Police Force of the Borough of Southmont shall be 2% of the first \$400.00 of monthly income and 5% of any amount over \$400.00 to be deducted from the Borough pay-rolls and paid into said fund by the Borough Secretary.

Section 5. That the proper officers of the Borough are hereby directed annually to make appropriations out of the General Funds of the Borough in sufficient amount to cover the Borough's share of said fund.

Section 6. That the proper officers of the Borough be and they are hereby authorized and directed to do and perform all acts and things necessary and proper to put said Pension Plan in effect as of December 31, 1958, and thereafter to maintain it in force in accordance with the requirements of Act No. 600, approved May 29, 1956 and as now or hereafter amended.

Section 7. Any ordinance or part of any ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.

Section 8. This ordinance shall go into effect December 31, 1958.
