

ORDINANCE NO. 124

PROVIDING AND CONDEMNING A RIGHT OF WAY FOR CONSTRUCTING  
A SANITARY AND STORM SEWER THROUGH CERTAIN LOTS IN THE  
BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town  
Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa.,  
and it hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of  
said Council that a right of way extending through lots 871 and  
897 along the northerly boundary line of said lots shall be  
and the same hereby is condemned to provide a right of way  
or easement for constructing an 8" sanitary and a 12" storm  
sewer marked and known as Drain No. 6 on the Borough Map,  
extending from Daisy Street to Dublin Street.

Section 2. That the center line of the sanitary sewer shall be  
2.55 feet and the center line of the storm sewer shall be  
4.05 feet South of the Northerly boundary lines of Lots  
871 and 897.

Section 3. That viewers shall be appointed according to law to  
appraise the damages and benefits if any by reason of said  
condemnation and constructing and maintaining said sanitary  
sewer if same cannot be amicably adjusted.

Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in con-  
flict with this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are  
repealed.
