

ORDINANCE NO. 100

ACCEPTING A PORTION OF THOBURN STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA., AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY ESTABLISHING THE WIDTHS, DRAINAGE FOR THE GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAME ON THE FOOT FRONT PLAN WITHOUT A PETITION AND APPROPRIATING THE MONEY FOR THE SAID GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAID PORTION OF THOBURN STREET.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that, that portion of Thoburn Street from its intersection with State Street to its intersection with Leile Street, within the limits of the Borough of Southmont Cambria County, Pa., shall be and the same hereby is accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. That the width of said portion of Thoburn Street, shall be established and the same hereby is established at sixty feet; that the width of the road way and sidewalks shall be established and the same hereby are established at thirty-six feet from face to face of curb for roadway, and twelve feet from face of curb to property line for sidewalks.

Section 3. That Thoburn Street from its intersection with State Street to its intersection with Leile Street, including the necessary highway intersections and returns, shall be and the same hereby is authorized to be graded, drained, curbed, and paved with a reinforced cement concrete pavement or such other type of pavement as may be adopted by the Borough Council, together with all necessary sanitary sewers, storm sewers, manholes, drop inlets and all other work incidental thereto, in accordance with the plans, specifications and directions of the Borough Engineer, as per Ordinance without a petition introduced in Council on the 9th day of June, A. D. 1930 and as provided by Act of the General Assembly of 1915, P.L. No. 312, Chapter VI, Article VII, Sections 9 to 17 inclusive and amendments thereto.

Section 4. That the Committee on Highways and Sewers shall be authorized and hereby are authorized to proceed with the advertisements and completion of said work on the foot front plan without a petition as provided by Act of 1915 P.L. No. 312 and amendments thereto.

Section 5. That one-third of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said portion of Thoburn Street, together with all incidental work thereto, shall be appropriated and the same hereby is appropriated and the Borough Treasurer authorized to make payments of same from time to time on estimates prepared by the Borough Engineer and approved by the Borough Council.

Section 6. That two-thirds of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said portion of Thoburn Street, together with all incidental work thereto, and the total cost of all curbing and sanitary sewers, as provided by the Borough Ordinance, shall be assessed and the same hereby is assessed on the foot front plan to the abutting property owners.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
