

TAX ORDINANCE NO. 250

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1967, AND ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES AND WAGE SCALE FOR THE YEAR 1967.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Southmont, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1967, as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of twelve (12) mills on each dollar assessed valuation; making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of twelve (12) mills.

SECTION 2. That the salaries or other compensation of Borough Officials, Appointees and Employees be fixed as follows:

Secretary	\$100.00	per month
Treasurer	65.00	per month
Street Commissioner	500.00	per month
Mayor	30.00	per month
Policemen	375.00	per month
Chief of Police	400.00	per month
Parttime Police & Extra hrs.	2.00	per hour
Truck Drivers	2.05	per hour
Regular Laborers	1.65	minimum per hour
	1.75	maximum per hour
Extra Laborers	1.50	per hour

SECTION 3. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same effects this ordinance.
