

ORDINANCE NO. 46

VACATING HENRY ALLEY AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN THE
BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA., AND RESERVING
CERTAIN RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND EASEMENTS THEREIN.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that Henry Alley, between Orchard Street and Diamond Boulevard, as shown on the Borough map, shall be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That the right-of-way for all necessary and convenient sewers, water lines, gas lines, power and telephone lines now installed or that it may hereinafter be necessary to install in Henry Alley, herein above vacated with the free and unrestricted right of ingress, egress and regress at all times for constructing, maintaining and making the necessary repairs and extensions from time to time without any liabilities to the Borough or any Public Service Corporation shall be and the same hereby are reserved by the Borough of Southmont.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
