Special Council Meeting May 11, 1998 7:30 p.m.

President Pile called to order the Special Council Meeting at 7:40 p.m. After the pledge to the flag, the May 11, 1998 meeting convened.

PRESENT: Mr. Rodgers, Mr. Rovansek, Mr. Krupa, Mr. Kory , Mr. Leventry, Mr. Pile and Mayor Lary Koval.

President Pile informed Council the reason for this second Special Meeting was to interview the applicants who sent resumes to fill the council vacancy of Mr. Curtis Davis, who no longer is a resident of the Borough. Edward Danyluk, William Lewis, Thomas Strittmater and Karen Posella were interviewed prior to the meeting.

At this time Mr. Rodgers moved to an executive session at 7:40 p.m. to discuss the candidates. Motion seconded by Mr. Leventry. All in favor. Council reconvened at 8:20 p.m., at which time Mr. Rodgers made a motion to appoint Mr. Edward Danyluk to fill the unexpired term of Mr. Curt Davis. Motion seconded by Mr. Krupa. The vote was 3-3. Mayor Koval cast a no vote to break the tie.

Mr. Leventry made a motion to approve a paper ballot vote, with Mayor Koval to vote in the event of a tie vote. Seconded by Mr. Rodgers. All in favor, motion carried. Mayor Koval counted the ballots. Again, there was a tie three votes for Mr. Danyluk and three votes for Mr. Strittmatter. Mayor Koval broke the tie voting for Mr. Strittmatter. Mr. Strittmatter will attend the May 20, 1998 meeting, at which time he will be appointed to Council to fill the vacancy of Mr. Curt Davis.

Council discussed the possibility of installing a soda machine in the Community Park at the storage facility. Representatives of Coke have offered a 15% reimbursement. Mayor Koval will check with other soda companies who might be interested in the possibilty of installing a soda machine. No other business was discussed.
