

ORDINANCE NO. 133

MODIFYING ORDINANCE NO. 68 OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR BUILDING PERMITS AND PLANS, REGULATING THE OPEN SPACES OR VACANT LOT AREAS BETWEEN BUILDINGS AND PROPERTY LINES, ESTABLISHING MINIMUM WIDTH OF SIDE YARDS AND PROVIDING FOR PROCURING OF BUILDING PERMITS IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA., AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAME.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of the same,

Section 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 68 shall be amended by adding the following:

All buildings permits issued under the authority hereof shall expire and be void one year from the date of issuance.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
