

ORDINANCE NO. 185

Providing for the Acceptance of Peach Alley as a Public Highway.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that Peach Alley from its intersection with the southerly line of Apple Alley to the northerly line of Southmont Blvd. and running between Lot No. 642 and Lot No. 643 on the Plan of Southmont laid out by C.P. Collins March 5, 1907, for Cambria Land and Improvement company Limited, shall be accepted and the same hereby is accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
