

ORDINANCE NO. 257

ORDINANCE RE-ENACTING ORDINANCE 253 PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING, ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF A TAX FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES AT THE RATE OF ONE-HALF PER CENT (1/2 of 1%) UPON EARNED INCOME AND NET PROFITS RECEIVED BY RESIDENTS OF AND BUSINESSES CONDUCTED IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT DURING THE YEAR 1968, UNDER AUTHORITY OF "THE LOCAL TAX ENABLING ACT", AND PROVIDING FOR CONTINUANCE IN FORCE OF SUCH TAX.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Southmont, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

That the Income Tax Ordinance which imposed taxes for general Borough purposes, as follows:

- (a) One-half (1/2) per cent of all compensation earned by residents during the year beginning January 1, 1968, and ending December 31, 1968; and
- (b) One-half (1/2) per cent of all net profits earned in or by business, professions and other activities conducted by residents during January 1, 1968 and ending December 31, 1968,

has been re-enacted without substantial change and the same imposed for the year 1969.
