

ORDINANCE NO. 154

ACCEPTING A PORTION OF WONDER STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, ESTABLISHING THE WIDTHS, PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAME, ON THE FOOT FRONT PLAN AND APPROPRIATING THE MONEY FOR THE SAID GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAID PORTION OF WONDER STREET.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same that, that portion of Wonder Street from its intersection with Thoburn Street to its intersection with Dell Street within the limits of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., shall be accepted and the same hereby is accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. That the width of said portion of Wonder Street shall be established and the same hereby is established at sixty feet; that the width of the roadway and sidewalk shall be established and the same hereby are established at twenty four (24) feet from face to face of curb for roadway and eighteen (18) feet from face of curb to property line for sidewalks.

Section 3. That Wonder Street from its intersection with Thoburn Street to its intersection with Dell Street shall be and the same hereby is authorized to be graded, drained, curbed and paved with H E Amesite pavement together with all other work incidental thereto in accordance with the plans specifications and directions of the Borough Engineer, as per ordinance introduced in Council on the 8th day of May 1950.

Section 4. That the Committee on Highways and Sewers shall be authorized and hereby are authorized to proceed with the advertisements and completion of said work on the foot-front plan.

Section 5. That one-third of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said portion of Wonder Street, together with all incidental work thereto, shall be appropriated and the same hereby is appropriated and the Borough Treasurer authorized to make payments of same from time to time on estimates prepared by the Borough Engineer and approved by the Borough Council.

Section 6. That two-thirds of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said portion of Wonder Street, together with all incidental work thereto, and the total cost of all curbing as provided by the borough ordinance, shall be assessed and the same is hereby assessed on the foot front plan to the abutting property owners.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
