

ORDINANCE NO. 128

PROVIDING FOR A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON A CERTAIN
HIGHWAY IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and its hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same that the maximum speed limits on that portion of State Highway Route #11011 Spurr Section 1, Traffic Route #271 within the limits of the Borough of Southmont, beginning on the Westerly boundary line of the Borough of Southmont where said highway intersects the Borough of Westmont and extending eastwardly along said Route #271 to the intersection of same with the boundary line between Southmont Borough and the City of Johnstown, shall be and hereby is established at thirty five(35) miles per hour.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
