

ORDINANCE NO. 49

PROVIDING FOR CONSTRUCTING A SANITARY SEWER THROUGH PRIVATE PROPERTY FROM DIAMOND BOULEVARD TO ORCHARD STREET APPROPRIATING RIGHT-OF-WAY AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF VIEWERS TO ASSESS DAMAGES AND BENEFITS.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that a sanitary sewer be constructed through private property from the northerly side of Diamond Boulevard to the southerly side of Orchard Street, on a course N.2° 16'E. 216 feet, more or less and being an extension of the line dividing Lots 181 and 182, as shown on the Southmont Plan of Lots dated March 5th, 1907 and being the same location as the sewer line shown on said map.

Section 2. That a right of way of sufficient width for constructing and maintaining a sanitary sewer at the location described in section 1, shall be and hereby is appropriated.

Section 3. That viewers be appointed according to law to assess damages done and benefits accruing, if any, by reason of laying out and constructing said sanitary sewers and appropriating said right of way if same cannot be amicably agreed upon between the Borough of Southmont and property owners affected by said improvements.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.

Passed finally in Council this 11th day of May 1926.
