

ORDINANCE NO. 106

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF TAXES IN PERIODIC INSTALLMENTS, AND SPECIFYING THE CONDITIONS AND PENALTIES IN SUCH CASES.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Burress and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:

Section 1. All taxes levied and assessed, or hereafter levied or assessed, for Borough purposes against all property in the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, may at the option of the taxpayer, be paid in three equal installments: The first installment on or before June 30th, the second installment on or before November 29, and the third installment on or before February 28, of each year following the levy.

Section 2. To each installment on the date when the same shall become delinquent, a penalty of five per centum shall be added, which shall be collectible in the same manner as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. Payment of the first installment of tax shall be conclusive evidence of the intention of the taxpayer to pay on the installment plan; and in the event that thereafter the said taxpayer shall permit one-half or more, of the total number of installments of taxes to become delinquent, an additional penalty of three per centum shall be added to each such delinquent installment.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
