

ORDINANCE NO.31

PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF PALLISER STREET AND APPROPRIATING THE MONEY FOR THE GRADING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAID PALLSIER STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordaned and it hereby is enacted and ordained by the Burgess and the Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, that that portion of Palliser Street from its intersection with Marion Street to tis intersection with the line between the Borough of Southmont and Upper Yoder Township, all within the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, shall be and the same hereby is authorized to be graded, curbed and paved the entire width of 24 feet between curbs with a reinforced concrete pavement, together with all the necessary sanitary and storm sewers, manholes, drain inlets and all other work incidental thereto, in accordance with the plans, specifications and directions of the Borough Engineer. The Committee on highways and sewers shall be authorized and hereby are authoized to proceed with said work on the foot front plan and in accordance with the petition on file for the paving of said portion of Palliser Street.

Section 2. That one-third of the total cost of grading, paving, and improving of said Palliser Street in excess of its portion of all moneys appropriated by the County of Cambria, shall be appropriated and hereby is appropriated and the Borough Treasurer is hereby authoized to make payments on same from time to time on estimates prepared by the Borough Engineer approved by the Borough Council.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
